The Regional Exhibition provides our artist community a museum environment to exhibit artwork and opportunities to connect with fellow artists, patrons, and enthusiasts.

SUBMISSIONS

Artists may submit up to two entries. Only original work produced within the last two years is eligible for entry. Painting, drawing, photography, sculpture, mixed-media, new media, crafts, jewelry, furniture, ceramics, and fiber arts are welcome.

ELIGIBILITY

The 82nd Regional Exhibition of Art & Craft is open to all artists and crafters who live within 30 miles of Fitchburg. This restriction is intended to support and encourage the artists of our geographic region, not exclude those interested in participating who might be at the margins of this radius.
